 The NWS partners with USGS, US ACE, local government (ex. City of Burlington) and others to monitor rivers

Volunteer observers take rain and snow measurements

Our Goal: Understand local impacts of flooding and communicate those risks



## NWS Flood Inundation Mapping



- Visual tool to understand flooding impacts
- Based on NWS flood warning categories
- Understand flood severity and risk based on potential impacts to property and public safety
  - Where and when flooding may occur



- Make decisions to mitigate flood risk, promote preparedness
- Provide timely response during a flood
- How deep will the water be at a location? What roads/parks/etc will the water cover?
- Assess how/when river levels may affect your interests and research

 Flood inundation mapping project was a cooperative effort by WI Emergency Management, NWS, WI DNR and FEMA








Select a River Gauge
